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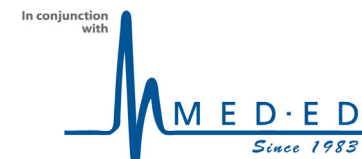

- Have completed 30 hours of continuing education in nursing professional development within the last three years.
